Article 6 Section 5 of the rules on student punishment (subject to other disciplinary action) has been established to prevent fraud in class attendance, examinations and others.

[Disciplinary Actions]

**Expulsion** - Expulsion from the University is the permanent separation and removal from the University.

- Suspension Suspension from the University prohibits the student from attending all classes, enrolling in any University courses, banned from all University facilities, and prohibited from any University activities for the period of the suspension.
- **Reprimand** The student is given official written notification and oral warning that the behavior has been unacceptable.
- \* Once the disciplinary decision is made, the University will send the notification to the student's guarantor. (Guarantor is the person who signed the guarantee upon admission. Basically the person is the guardian.)

## [Card Touch Fraud]

It is also prohibited to hand over the student ID card to other students. Not only the owner of the student ID card, but also students who carried out the card touch fraud will be imposed disciplinary actions.

[Disclosure and Responses for the Acts of Academic Dishonesty]

If the faculty or staff members discover students' acts of academic dishonesty, they will report all instances to the School Committee to discuss the disciplinary

actions.

Even if the students were not aware of acts of academic dishonesty or consequences, they will face punishment.

The following correspondence will be made if the student received disciplinary actions due to the committee's result of deliberations:

- Contact to the guarantor
- Disciplinary actions published within campus.
- Current semester's credits will be marked as 'Fail'.
  XAs a result, promotion or graduation may be delayed.

In the second term of 2015 academic year, a number of students have already been reported to the School Committee discussing the punishment about the acts of academic dishonesty mentioned above.

Please note that there is a case in the past that a student who had carried out such academic dishonesty received the grade of 'Fail' in all courses in the semester. You will regret later if you are engaged in academic dishonesty. Good luck on your exams, reports or assignments.
